RAMS, Inc. announces the re-introduction of JumpStart Skill Trades Training this month by conducting its first class in Ft. Myers since 2008. JumpStart was originally introduced in 2004 and between then and 2008 over 800 new pre-apprentices were trained and deployed into Florida's commercial Electrical and Mechanical industries.

JumpStart is a state approved (P.065), fully monitored, twenty-six week pre-apprenticeship program that was developed to promote a higher quality of entry-level skilled trades personnel. All students receive extensive safety training (OSHA-10), discipline-based (electrical, plumbing, or structured cable) theoretical and practical (mobile simulator supported) education, hand and power tools, personal protective equipment, mentoring and follow-up classroom training over the 180 day program.

JumpStart has been and will continue to be the best answer to industries need for new highly motivated and trained tradesmen. By working with contractors during the OJT phase, the contractor can assist in the training, mentoring, and grow the student into their next generation employee.

The recession has created a need to bring in younger employees and reduce the average hourly cost of our clients. Additional classes are forming around the state and seeking contractors to join RAMS in sponsoring and training Florida's next generation of skilled trades professionals.
